Technical Planning Committee

- 1. There are a couple changes to the 2008-2009 calendar.
 - SEVA is hosting a LC Head Start meet on March 28-29 at MAC.
 - RAYS is hosting an Open Water Event the end of May
 - ODAC has moved its Ocean Swim to the following weekend.
 - OBX will be hosting a LC Invitational meet in early June
 - CGBD will be hosting a prelim/final LC Invitational the end of June
- 2. CGBD has submitted a bid to host LC Age Group Champs at MAC on July 20-August 2 (the scheduled weekend). We have no other bids.
- 3. Team assignments for the summer awards have been posted to the VSI website.
- 4. 2009-2010 Schedule template has been posted to the VSI website. We will accept bids immediately for the upcoming year through April 6th. Our objective is to present the 2008-2009 schedule at the April HOD and board meeting.
- 5. District Champs and Region Champs have been completed. The biggest issue reported was the suitability of the Regency Park facility for a championship meet. There was some confusion at the TW Region champs about relay eligibility.
- 6. The following is a breakdown of swimmers and splashes at each district and region championship meet:
 - District Champs (2008 numbers in parenthesis):
 - o North District: 724 (661) Swimmers; 3242 (2934) Splashes; 159 (140) Relays
 - o Central District: 809 (716) Swimmers; 3830 (3462) Splashes; 179 (150) Relays
 - o Southeast District: 603 (533) Swimmers; 2889 (2649) Splashes; 129 (118) Relays
 - o Southwest District: 442 (380) Swimmers; 2186 (1909) Splashes; 78 (74) Relays
 - Region Champs (2008 numbers in parenthesis):
 - o Tidewater Region: 638 (608) Swimmers; 3647 (3358) Splashes; 233 (196) Relays
 - o Blue Ridge Region: 574 (642) Swimmers; 3192 (3604) Splashes; 181 (190) Relays
 - o Northern Virginia Region: 677 (754) Swimmers; 3597 (3952) Splashes; 194 (211) Relays

- As reported previously, we should continue to monitor the numbers for each of these championship meets.
 - Total participation at district champs was up about 12% (288 swimmers; 1193 splashes; 63 relays).
 - Total participation at region champs was down about 3% (115 swimmers;
 478 splashes; up 11 relays).
 - Meets held just prior to the district champs do not seem to affect participation at district champs as much as qualifying times do
 - o As we make the qualifying times for age group champs and senior champs higher it increases the athlete pool for region champs.
 - Should we consider a separate 8&U Awards Meet to reduce numbers at the District Champs?
