ELIGIBILITY:	 Open to all USA Swimming/VSI registered swimmers meeting eligibility requirements for the meet All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. 13-14 swimmers must have one "BB" time in two different strokes to enter all 13-14 events. Any swimmer entering as a senior swimmer must have 15-16 "BB" time in each event entered. No on deck registration will be permitted. 2005-2008 NAG top 16 based times are in effect. Age on December 10, 2004 will determine age for the entire meet. 					
FORMAT:	 All events will be trial-finals event, except for events 9, 10, 11, 12, 23, 24, 31, 32, 33 & 34, which will be timed final events. Trial sessions: Warm-ups at 7:00-8:30am; competition starts at 8:45am. Final sessions: Warm-ups at 4:15-5:45pm; competition starts at 6:00pm. Final sessions on Sunday: Warm-ups at 3:15-4:45; competition at 5:00pm. All events will be combined age groups in trials and separated during finals as 13-14 & senior. Top 24 13-14 & top 24 senior swimmers will swim finals (Bonus, Consolation, and Super Final). General warm-up procedure will be in place between 7:00-8:10 am & 4:15-5:25 pm with the remaining 20 minutes of warm-up for each session being broken into specific warm-up lanes There will be 8 lanes of continuous warm-up/ warm-down lanes available. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which may require reseeding. 					
ENTRIES:	 DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2004. Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. Teams may submit entries as an e-mail attachment (preferred) or on a 3 ½" computer disk. A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet (available through the VSI Website (www.virginiaswimming.org) with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. Non-conforming times will be converted to short course yard times prior to seeding. All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events and 1 relay event per day. Relay teams must be designated A and B. Each team is allowed two relays teams per event. Entries will be processed in the order received. SEEDING:	All events, except events 9, 10, 11, 12, 23, 24, 31, 32, 33, & 34 will be pre-seeded.						
	• Events 9, 10 (1000 Free), 11, 12 (200 Free Relay), 23, 24 (200 Medley Relay), 31, 32 (400 Free Relay), 33, & 34 (1650 Free) will require a positive check-in to swim.						
	Positive check-in will close at 8:30 am on Friday for events 9, 10, 11, & 12.						
	Positive check-in will close at 8:30 am on Saturday for events 23 & 24.						
	Positive check-in will close at 8:30 am on Sunday for events 31, 32, 33, & 34.						
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.						
	Events 9, 10, 33, & 34 will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys.						
	Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. There will be a late fee charge for Deck Entries.						
	Late entries fee will be \$4.00 for individuals and \$8.00 for relay.						
	The scratch procedures specified in the 2004 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 207.7.9, sections D and E will apply.						
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:						
	Swimmer shall be disqualified from the event entered illegally and the event shall be rescored and awarded.						
	 Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. 						
	Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with United States Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.						
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.						
RULES:	The 2004 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.						
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the afternoon sessions, and may be used for the morning sessions at the discretion of the Referee.						
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

TIMERS:	Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be to the club by December 5, 2004, and will be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs					
GENERAL:	Swimmer / Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers / spectators. Smoking is prohibited on the Hargrave campus. Please help keep your area clean of waste.
