	FACILITY: Two 8 lane 25 yard courses with Kiefer lane lines will be utilized. Colorado timing systems with scoreboard display will be used. The shallow end will be available for supervised warm-up and cool-down throughout the meet.		
Rules	Current USA Swimming and PVS Swimming rules will govern this meet. Please pay special attention to USA Swimming Rules; 202.3.2: <i>At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.</i>		
Eligibility	Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming and be between the ages of 11 and 14 to be accepted in this meet. Age as of February 26, 2010, shall determine swimmer's age for the entire meet. Coaches MUST constantly display their current USA Swimming coach credentials to gain deck access. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current. Swimmers MUST have a minimum IMX score of 1,800 points to enter this meet.		
	In order to get an IMX qualifying score, a swimmer MUST compete in all 5 or 6 events.Do not run your IMX scores from Team Manager. TM will give you a score even if you do not swim all IMX events.		

Format	This will be an IMX meet. All athletes must participate in all events.
