| ELIGIBILITY: | - Open to all USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming 12 years' old and younger athletes registered by the first day of the meet. <br> - Swimmers with two "BB" times at any distance one each in different strokes including IM as the fifth stroke can swim any event offered in the BB+ session. <br> - Swimmers not qualified for the $B B+$ session can swim any event offered in the $B / C$ session. <br> - Swimmers may only swim relays in the session they are qualified to compete. <br> - 2009-2012 NAG times are in effect. <br> - No on deck USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. <br> - Age on October 10, 2009 will determine age for the entire meet. |
