ELIGIBILITY:	 Open to all Virginia Swimming registered athletes in Tidewater Region registered by the first day of the meet. Teams in the Tidewater Region are: BAC, CGBD, OBX, ODAC, PRO, SEVA, SSC, TAC, TCAC, TIDE, US, VYAC, & WAC The qualifying period for this meet is January 1, 2009 through February 25, 2010 No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. 14 and younger swimmers may compete in any event in which they have at least a "BB" time, but a time that is slower than the age group championship qualifying time. 15 and older swimmers may compete in any event in which they have a time that is slower than the senior championship qualifying time. Swimmers may not swim a relay in any event (stroke and distance) in which they possess an Age Group Championship (14 and younger) or Senior Championship (15&O) qualifying time. 2009-2012 NAG time standards are in effect. Age on February 26, 2010 will determine age for the entire meet. 10 & 12 year old swimmers aging up from February 27 to March 18, 2010, and 14 year old swimmers aging up from February 27 to March 4, 2010 with times too fast to qualify for this championship will be allowed to compete under the following conditions: Any 10 or 12 year old swimmer who does not qualify in their new age group at Age Group Champs may enter the event. Any 14 year old swimmer who does not qualify to swim at Senior Champs may enter the event. 10, 12, & 14 year old swimmers aging up between championships will be seeded correctly by time, however will swim exhibition only, and will not be eligible to receive an award or
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	 compete in the finals session. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	 All 12 & Younger swimmers will swim timed finals in the afternoon session. All 13 & Older swimmers will swim a preliminary session in the morning session. The top 16 swimmers in 13-14 and the top 16 swimmers in 15&O will swim the final session each day.
WARM-UP:	 Pool Deck will not be open to swimmers, coaches, & spectators prior to 6:15 AM each day Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 6:30-7:30 AM; competition starts at 7:45 AM Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups at 2:00-3:00 PM; competition starts at 3:15 PM

- Finals sessions: Warm-ups at 6:30-7:15 PM; competition starts at 7:30 PM
- During the last 10 minutes of each warm-up sessions the following rules shall apply:
 - Lanes 1 & 8 of the competition pool are designated as pace lanes, lanes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7
 of the competition pool are designated as one-way starts and sprints
 - Lanes in the non-competition pool will be designated as general warm-up during this period.
- 1000 and 1650 freestyles: The pool will be opened for 15 minutes of open warm-ups immediately following the finish of the relay events, with the 1000 (Friday) and 1650 (Sunday) freestyle competition starting 5 minutes thereafter.

 - o The distance sessions will start no earlier than the estimated times.

- If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.

DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2010

- Conforming and Non-conforming times will be used for entry Short Course Yards then Long Course Meters then Short Course Meters. Non-conforming times will be seeded following all conforming times.
- Entries must be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.
- Teams submit entries as an e-mail attachment.
- A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the VSI meet summary sheet (available
 at VSI website, www.virginiaswimming.org) with the name, email address, and phone number of
 the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they
 are submitted.
- 12 and younger swimmers may enter a maximum of 9 individual events, no more than 3 pre day.
- 13 and older swimmers may enter a maximum of 8 individual events, no more than 3 per day.
- Relay teams must be designated A, B, or C, if more than one per club is entered per event. Teams may submit three (3) relays per event.
 - Relay entry times must be slower than the combined VSI SC Age Group Championship qualifying time for 14 & younger swimmers and must be slower than the combined VSI SC Senior Championship qualifying time for 15 & older swimmers for the corresponding relay.
 - See the "not faster than" relay times chart on page 5.
- The Meet Director reserves the right to combine heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.
- Proof of entry times is required for individual events. Entries must include a report showing
 the date and the meet each swimmer's entry times were achieved. Entries without proof of time
 will be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
- Incomplete entries not resolved prior to the meet entry deadline will be considered late entries and late fees will be charged accordingly.
- Times of swimmers not making the meet qualifying time will be checked and the club notified if there is a problem.
- 15 & Older swimmers without a time of record in an event may enter with a coach's time.
 Such times must be so indicated on the proof of times and can not be faster than the 15-16 "B" time standard for the event entered. "No Time" (NT) entries will not be accepted.
- Additional proof of ENTRY time, if requested, must be provided to the Age Group Chairman
 within two (2) weeks of the request. Times not satisfactorily proved in that length of time will be
 considered non-verifiable and a fine will be assessed.
