FACILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eleven (11) lane 25 yard indoor pool, 7-9 feet in depth. All sessions will be run using a eight lane course for competition with two additional lanes for continuous warm-up/warm-down.• Facility uses a Daktronics Automatic Timing System with 10-lane scoreboard and Kiefer Wave Eater racing lane lines.• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 104.2.2(C).

ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open to all USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming athletes registered by the first day of the meet• No on deck USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.• Age on October 31, 2009 will determine age for the entire meet.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.• The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All swimmers will swim in a single session on both Saturday and Sunday• All events will be timed finals.
WARM-UP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Warm-up: 7:30 AM; Competition starts: 8:30 AM• Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the www.swimwac.com, website no later than Tuesday, October 27, 2009 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.
ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS THURSDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2009</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Entries must be submitted in Short Course Yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.• Teams submit entries as an e-mail attachment• A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.• Coach's Times (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "B" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.• Swimmers may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual events</i> and <i>1 relay event</i> per day.• Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.• Entries will be processed in the order received. An e-mail will be sent confirming receipt of the teams' entries.• The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. FEES:	<p>Individual events: \$3.50 Relay events: \$12.00 Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checks should be made payable to: Williamsburg Aquatic Club • Payment must be received by October 27, 2009 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mailed entries. • Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
AWARDS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 10 & Under individual events will be given separate awards for 9-10 and 8 & Under age groups ○ 12 & Under individual events will be given separate awards for 11-12, 9-10, and 8 & Under age groups ○ 13 & over individual events will be divided into 13-14 and 15 & over age groups. • Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place. • All Swimmers entered in this meet will receive a Halloween Swim Cap as part of our Theme Meet
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events. • Events #47-48 (13&O 500 Free), 63-64 (13&O 1000 Free), 89-90 (12&U 500 Free), and 117-118 (13&O 1650 Free).will require a positive check-in to swim and will be reseeded if heats are eliminated. • Positive check-in will close at the end of warm-ups for the session in which the event is scheduled except for the distance sessions. • Distance Session positive check-in will close at 9:30 am • SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. • Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Meet Director.
PENALTIES:	<p>Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded. • Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. • Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with United States Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. • If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. • The overhead start procedure will be used for the afternoon sessions, and may be used for the morning sessions at the discretion of the Referee. • In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.
TIMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. • The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the WAC Website (www.swimwac.com) no later than Tuesday October 27th and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs.
GENERAL:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Officials and coaches hospitality will be available • Meet programs will be sold
FACILITY RULES:	<p>PLEASE CONVEY THIS INFORMATION TO YOUR SWIMMERS AND PARENTS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Picture identification will be required to gain access to the base. • Rules will be enforced by meet marshal, aquatic center staff and the Fort Eustis Fire Marshall. • Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator that violates Aquatic Center rules, posted at the pool and/or in the meet program, will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility. • The Aquatic Center prohibits food of any kind in the pool area. Consumption of food is allowed in the lobby area and the spectator balcony. Permissible beverages, sports drinks and water, must be in closed plastic containers. • Deck Access: Access to the pool deck will be strictly controlled. Swimmers, coaches, officials and event staff only will be permitted on the deck during warm-ups and the competition. • Balcony: Swimmers and their bags <u>will not be allowed</u> to stay in the area. Spectator seating is limited and swimmers must stay on the competition or adventure pool deck.
DIRECTIONS:	From I-64 take Exit 250 (Fort Eustis Blvd) towards Fort Eustis. This will take you onto the base. Go 4 blocks past security and through the circular intersection. Turn right at first Street (Tyler Road) past the circular intersection. The Aquatic facility is the building on your left. If the Aquatic Center lot is full, there are plenty of parking 100 yards down Tyler Road.
