The Carter Center Aquatics Swim Team (CCA), located in Roanoke, VA, is seeking applicants for one or two Asst Coaches. The Roanoke Valley is uniquely nestled among the Blue Ridge Mountains in southwestern Virginia. An outdoor paradise, Roanoke is located within three hours of Charlotte, Richmond, and the Washington DC environs.

CCA is an institutionally owned team by North Cross School, a K-12 private secondary school serving the Roanoke and New River Valleys. The US Swimming team currently boasts approximately 150 swimmers, ranging from novice to Junior National level swimming, as well as National top 16 qualifiers.

CCA is looking for a Senior Assistant Coach who will work will work alongside our Head Coach in the development and implementation of the senior program. The senior program currently has 45 swimmer's ranging from 'BB' to "Junior National qualifiers' We have produced USA-Junior National finalist, USA-Olympic Trial qualifiers and numerous state and regional champions. CCA takes pride in having the student-athletes take ownership in their training and work towards long and short term goals. A high number of swimmer's go on to participate in collegiate swimming in all levels.

Responsibilities and Expectations include but not limited to:

- 14-16 hours of on-deck coaching, Monday thru Friday evenings, some one-two mornings a week and Saturday AM. Overseeing and directing certain training levels within the senior program
- Assist the Head Coach in development and implementation of season planning for the entire senior program
- Strong knowledge, implementation and ability to oversee a dry land program
- Attending all staff meetings as required by the Head Coach
- Attending all 1-2 meets a month
- Works well with a diverse coaching staff.
- Ability to work well with all levels of swimmer abilities and ages.

The applicant must have experience coaching swimmers of all ages and have had experience coaching senior (high school aged) swimmers. The candidate must display a strong knowledge of current stroke techniques and is energetic and active on deck, enthusiastic about the opportunity and possess good communication skills. Our ideal candidate will possess high ethical and moral standards and will be as interested in our members' character development as they are in their development as swimmers. We are looking for a coach who has a passion to coach and mentor our swimmers!

Candidates must have experience with Team Unify, Team Manager and Microsoft Office. It is preferred candidates have at least 3 years competitive coaching experience. In addition, he/she must have all USA Swimming Certifications including a Background Check, Athlete Protection Training, Safety Training and CPR, and be in good standing with USA Swimming and their LSC.

In addition we may have a part-time age group coaching position available with our 14 & younger swimmers. The part-time age group coach will have similar expectation with less weekly hours. The senior assistant or part-time age group position could have the opportunity to be full time for the right candidate.
