	The qualifying period for this meet is January 1, 2017 through February 09, 2018		
	Swimmers 8 & younger may compete in any event offered.		
	Age on February 09, 2018 will determine age for the entire meet.		
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.		
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

	Entries must be submitted in short course meter times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.		
	Teams submit entries via e-mail		
	<ul> <li>A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Swimmers may enter a maximum of 8 individual events for the meet, no more than 4 per day and 1 relay event per day.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.</li> <li>Relay entry times must be slower than the combined "AG Championship" times for the corresponding relay.</li> </ul>

AWARDS:	<ul> <li>Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place in each event.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Awards will be given for each age group: 6 and under, 7 year olds and 8 year olds.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>High point awards will be given 1-3 for each age group. 6 and under, 7 year olds and 8 year olds.</li> </ul>
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded.
	Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events.
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	<ul> <li>Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
