FACILITY:	• Eleven (11) lane 25 yard indoor pool, 9 feet deep in lane 1 sloping to 7 feet deep lanes 7-11.with a Daktronics Automatic Timing System with a 10-lane scoreboard and Kiefer Wave Eater racing lane lines.			
	Manual timing, 3 watches per lane and Infinity starting system will be used			
	All sessions will be run using a six lane course for competition			
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4)

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all CGBD, SEVA, and WAC athletes eight years old and younger registered by the first day of the meet			
	No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.			
	Age on October 19, 2019 will determine age for the entire meet.			
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advanced notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.			
	• The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.			
FORMAT:	All swimmers will swim in one session			
	All events will be timed finals			
	4-minute breaks after each set of events; 10-minute break before the relays			
WARM-UP:	Warm-ups at 11:30 am; competition starts at 12:00 pm.			
	• Lane assignments for individual clubs will be posted on the CGBD website no later than Tuesday, October 15, 2019 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.			
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS FRIDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2019.			
	 Entries must be submitted in Short Course times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. 			
	Teams submit entries via e-mail			
	• A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.			
	 Coach Times (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT <u>must be slower than an "A" time.</u> All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. 			
	• Swimmers may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual events</i> and <i>1 relay event</i> per day.			
	 Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event. Email entries to: <u>coachsteve2423@gmail.com</u> 			

	 Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must submitted to the Administrative Official on the provided forms

	Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)

	• Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.			
AWARDS:	No awards will be presented.			
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded. Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events			
PENALTIES:	 A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as 			
	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. 			
	 Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. 			
	 Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. 			
	 If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. 			
	• Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.			
RULES:	• The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet.			
	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. 			
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.			
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. 			
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. 			
	 Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. 			
	• In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.			
	 In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

TIMERS:	Clubs may be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in meet.	
	 The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the CGBD website: <u>http://www.cgbdswimming.org</u> no later than Tuesday, October 16, 2018 and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs. 	
GENERAL:	• Concessions will be run by the Aquatic Center. Hospitality will have water for coaches and officials.	
	Heat sheets will be for sale for \$3.00.	
	• There will be an ice cream party following the meet in the glass room across from the front office.	
	• Swimmers are welcome to use the Adventure Pool following the ice cream party. Parents and siblings that wish to use the Adventure Pool will have to pay an entrance fee.	
FACILITY RULES:	PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY. RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY MEET MARSHALL, AQUATIC CENTER STAFF AND THE FORT EUSTIS FIRE MARSHALL.	
	FORT EUSTIS AUTOMOBILE ACCESS: DRIVERS LICENSE AND AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER FORT EUSTIS.	
	• Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator who violates Aquatic Center rules, posted at the pool and in the meet program, will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility.	
	• The Aquatic Center prohibits food of any kind in the pool area. Consumption of food is allowed in the lobby area and the spectator balcony. Permissible beverages, sports drinks and water, must be in closed plastic containers.	
	• Deck Access: Access to the competition pool deck will be strictly controlled. Swimmers, coaches, officials and event staff only will be permitted on the deck during warm-ups and the competition.	
	• SWIMMERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BALCONY AREA. THE BALCONY SEATING AREA WILL BE FOR SPECTATORS ONLY. SWIMMERS MUST STAY ON THE COMPETITION POOL DECK.	
	The Adventure Pool side of the building WILL NOT be available for seating.
