<b>FACILITY:</b>	25 yard indoor pool, 8 lanes, 5 feet deep at the start and turn end and 6 feet deep in the middle of the pool. Equipped with Non-turbulent lane lines. Daktronics Timing System. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , Article 104.2.2C(4).

<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	Open to all Virginia Gators Swimmers that are registered members Virginia Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. Age as of October 19, 2019 will determine age for the entire meet.
<b>DISABILITY SWIMMERS:</b>	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
<b>FORMAT:</b>	All events will be mixed gender and divided into 12 & Under as well as 13 & Over. 8 & Under swimmers will also have mixed 25's available to swim. Girls and boys will be swimming together in the mixed events but will be scored against their own gender at the conclusion of the meet for both teams.
<b>WARM-UP:</b>	Both the Saturday and Sunday session warm ups will start no later than 9:00am and continue until 9:50am. The session will start both days at approximately 10:00am Both sessions will be open warm up
<b>ENTRIES:</b>	<b>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2019</b> Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 <i>individual events and 1 relay events per day</i> . Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event. Entries will be processed in the order received and <b>accepted to</b> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.

<b>SEEDING:</b>	All events will be pre-seeded
<b>AWARDS:</b>	No awards will be given.

<b>PENALTIES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> <li>● Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.</li> <li>● Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> <li>● Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.</li> </ul>
<b>RULES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet.</li> <li>● All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>● Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> <li>● Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>● Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> <li>● Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.</li> <li>● In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool. In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.</li> </ul>
