The process is to attend a training clinic, then complete an apprentice period of 6-8 sessions, depending on the position. A session is a section of a swim meet like Saturday morning, Sunday afternoon, Saturday evening finals, etc.

You don't need to know anything about officiating or even swimming to start. By the completion of your apprentice period, you will be a fully-trained, competent swim official. <u>If you go to 4 or more swim meets</u> per year, we want to talk to you!

There will be a clinic for new officials in Waynesboro at the Waynesboro YMCA. The address is 648 S. Wayne Ave, Waynesboro, VA 22980. We will be holding wet deck and dry deck clinics on Thursday December 20th, 2018.

The wet deck clinic will be held from 7:00 - 9:00 pm for stroke & turn officials and the dry deck clinic will be from 6:00 - 8:00 pm. The same dry deck clinic starts the training for any of the three dry deck positions.
