Timing System Operator V2 Evaluation Criteria

Pre-Requisites:

- Certified in position at the V1 level for a minimum of one year
- Fully trained and qualified on the timing equipment

Session Requirements for Evaluation:

- Work a minimum of 4 sessions to include at least one each of the following:
 - Preliminary session
 - Finals session
 - Distance session
 - Time trials session

Interaction with the Officiating Team:

- Coordinates with the Administrative Referee prior to the start of the session
- Understands scope of authority
- Coordinates and interacts with the Timing Judge
- Handles special situations or concerns
- Acts in a diplomatic manner
- Keeps a calm demeanor during stressful situations

Knowledge of Equipment:

- Can perform a full equipment set-up including Relay Judging Pads (RJPs for CTS only)
- Can set-up printer (CTS only)
- Capable of trouble shooting equipment problems as they occur
- Capable of repairing or replacing any timing system component deemed faulty
- Displays appropriate judgment as to when to repair/replace equipment
- Capable of teaching/explaining all aspects of timing equipment operations

Record keeping:

- Heat sheet
 - Records race number for each heat
 - Records no-shows and adds in each heat
 - Records consolidated or added heats
 - Records manual starts
- Timing equipment print-out
 - Confirms that event #, heat #, race description correspond to race #
 - Records any anomalies that are personally observed
 - Indicates "manual start" as needed

Meet Operations:

- Coordinates with Starter to verify that all equipment is working prior to the scheduled start of the session
- Coordinates with the Recorder to verify that the session has been downloaded prior to the scheduled start of the session
- Informs the Deck Referee/Admin Referee/Timing Judge of any developing problems (equipment, lane timers)
- Can work at a pace that does not delay the starts
- Attentive during relays and adds/removes touches as required
- Attentive during distance events and adds touches as required
- Can retrieve stored race results
- Can manually program the timing equipment console for time trials
- Can run races of different lengths in the same heat during time trials
