Virginia Swimming Zone Team Staff Honor Code

As a staff member of Virginia Swimming's 2018 Eastern Zone Long Course Championship Swim Meet. I understand and will comply with the following guidelines and policies as set forth by Virginia Swimming at all times during the meet.
