Primarily we are looking for an enthusiastic, energetic, creative Assistant Coach to coach our morning Senior Swimmers.

- On deck coaching primarily weekday mornings 5:00 -8:00am (Tuesday Friday, some Saturdays). Other shifts may become available.
- Responsible for daily, weekly and season planning for the Senior group with the Head Coach and may attend 1 - 2 meets a month.
- Plans and conducts effective and progressive practices (in water and dryland) on a solo platform, with assistance from Head Coach.
